To receive .05 credit, get started by creating an account and registering on the <u>MNU</u> <u>Continuing Education website</u>.

You may receive additional hours of college credit for this course if you choose to apply it in your classroom and show impact (you have up to a year to complete all five components, parts 2-5)!

You also have the choice of ONLY requesting credit for attending the workshop and by completing the following three required steps for .05 credits:

- 1. Attend Accessibility Summer Camp 2024 on June 14
- 2. Register for CE Credit with MNU
- 3. Submit a completed STAR Assignment, only part one is required.
